25 Live Productions, LLC, Brandon Phillips and Paul Gongaware.

26 Katherine Jackson and Prince, Paris and Blanket Jackson are the plaintiffs. AEG Live,
27 LLC, AEG Live Productions, LLC, Brandon Phillips and Paul Gongaware are the defendants.

28 Plaintiffs allege that the defendants are liable for the death of Michael Jackson because



1 they negligently hired, retained or supervised Conrad Murray, a doctor who administered a fatal
2 dose of the anesthetic drug propofol to Michael Jackson on June 25, 2009. The plaintiffs seek
3 economic and noneconomic damages from the defendants.

4 Defendants deny that they hired Dr. Murray or that they were negligent, and dispute the
5 nature and extent of plaintiffs' damages.
